ATTR Mobility Grants 2022/2023

In order to help the PhD fellows to spend time at top-level academic institutions, ATTR funds mobility grants for regular ATTR members. The board awards the grants based on the relevance of the host institution for the applicant's PhD project and its relation to the aims and profile of ATTR.

Who can apply?

All PhD fellows and ATTR members from one of our partner institutions can apply.

Partner institutions are University of Bergen, University of Tromsø, NTNU, MF and University of Oslo.

If you are a guest member from another institution in Norway, your application can still be considered for funding, provided that you have participated in earlier ATTR activities.

We have measures in place assisting breastfeeding members to participate also in the use of mobility grants, and we urge these members to apply.

Deadline

Deadline for the application is October 1, 2022

Deadline for spending the grant is September 1, 2023

Research plan

- Your application needs to include a research plan reflecting how your travel will promote your research into textual scholarship and your international networking.
- The research plan should show the relevance of the host institution, and your planned activities there, preferably also the name of your local contact / supervisor.
- The plan may also include details of your local involvement (e.g., supervision, paper presentation, courses, meetings, archival work, etc.)

Confirmation letters

- A letter of invitation from the host institution or the host supervisor should be submitted with the application.
- Your primary supervisor must confirm approval for the travel through a brief written statement of support.

- Your application should include a simple budget for your travel expenses. The grant can be used to cover expenses directly related to your journey, such as costs for travel, housing, conference fees, etc., Indirect expenses like book purchase or insurance are not covered.
- Please note that after the travel you must provide original receipts for all expenses. If such documentation cannot be provided, the parts of the grant that has not been accounted for will be reported to the tax authorities as income.
